### 1.3 President Report

- She states a lot of the summer has been spent in getting to know this role; familiarize herself on how to get things done

## 1.6 Other Business - Clubs Prohibition Status

- Dominic & Devin reviewed Clubs Manual; he's recommending in changing club prohibition status from one academic term to one full academic year
- Some discussion on how funding will be disbursed; Dominic indicates he'll meet with committee to determine how funds are allocated
- After reading the Manual and seeing what could be approved upon, he feels a full academic year would be
  a better way to gauge how a club or society could perform rather than a four month period

- Hope to have centre open by the end of September
